For **Experienced Students** the course will aim to improve knowledge of oils and /or acrylics through various techniques related to either medium. With oils techniques such as impasto, alla prima, scumbling etc will be covered. The use of both brushes and painting knives will be used.

Students with experience bring materials that you have. The first lesson will be drawing.
