This course enables you to gain appreciation and satisfaction of working with and handling wood. To handle and use carving tools in a safe way, gaining confidence in their use and tackling any carving project you may wish to undertake. I would expect a beginner to be in a position at the end of the course to have carved two or three basic carvings, depending on the projects chosen. To have the 'know how' from design to finished piece.

- There is no work required outside the class time, only if the student wishes.
- No previous experience is necessary
- Beginners projects are available at a small charge
- Some timber for later projects are available but students are encouraged to look out for suitable materials.

After the first meeting, tuition will be on a 'one to one' basis.

**Progression** – Ongoing personal development within the class. Learners are given the opportunity to attend National Workshops and International classes with their tutor in Austria twice yearly.
