Introduction :

This course is designed to enable you to communicate with the deaf people using British Sign Language at the intermediate level. It also aims to provide some information about deaf people, the deaf community and deaf culture. During the course you will learn the following themes :

- Everyday Conversation
- Eating and Drinking
- Spending and Shopping
- Travel and Holidays

By the end of the course you should be able to have a wider grasp of the use of BSL syntax and grammar as well as extending your vocabulary in the use of the themes above

Who is the course for?

This course is for those who have passed BSL Level 1. Learners who do not possess the full BSL Level 1 certification and have good signing skills must complete their BSL Level 1 certification during the first term of the course. Students may wish to extend their learning for any reason, family and friends or use within a work environment.

You will be assessed on 3 units, details below, which are externally assessed by Signature who are the awarding body. Passing all 3 leads to full BSL Level 2 certification.

The three units are :

- Unit 201 - Receptive Skills
- Unit 202 - Productive Skills
- Unit 203 - Conversational Skills

PROGRESSION - It will be noted that this qualification is a recognised second language qualification for an increasing numbers of careers. This course is the pre-requisite qualification should one wishes to proceed to Level 3 of the British Sign Language.
